SELFIE WITH A SENIOR AWARD TERMS AND CONDITIONS 2025

The Selfie with a Senior Award coincides with the Portrait of a Senior Territorian Art Award, which recognises and celebrates the achievements and contributions of senior Territorians to our community. The Selfie with a Senior Award is an innovative avenue for individuals to participate in the prestigious Portrait of a Senior Territorian Art Award.

This unique category invites participants to submit a photograph featuring themselves and a senior, alongside a statement of how the senior has inspired them.

This aims to encapsulate the stories, rich experiences and profound wisdom of the elder generation. By showcasing the intergenerational connections through imagery, the award celebrates the bonds between different age groups and the narratives that bridge them. This initiative aims to foster artistic expression, promote respect, understanding and appreciation for seniors and their invaluable contributions to society.

Applicants for this award have the opportunity to win a prize of \$1000, or $2 \times 100 vouchers, generously donated by COTA NT.

This agreement outlines the mutual expectations of both parties prior to and during the Selfie with a Senior Award 2025, alongside the Portrait of a Senior Territorian Art Award 2025.

Residency Requirement: Participants and subjects must currently reside in the Northern Territory.

Eligibility to Enter: This award is open to artists 16 years and over, on the date the applications close. A parent or guardian is required to complete the application form for anyone under 18 years of age.

Submission Deadline: Application forms (with attached photographs and statements) must be submitted by the end of the day on **Monday 9th June**. No late entries will be accepted.

Timeframe: Photographs must have been taken within the last 12 months, of the application closing date.

Image Quality: The photograph included in the application must be a high-resolution image, (at least 200ppi).

Exhibition: The winning selfie will be displayed at the Portrait of a Senior Territorian Art Award exhibition.

Winning Application: A prize of \$1000 will be awarded to the winning applicant. Two runners up will be awarded a \$100 voucher.





Payment of Winners: Payment of prize monies will be coordinated by COTA NT in accordance with the Northern Territory Government protocols.

Application Process: Participants must submit a fully completed online application form after reading the Terms and Conditions.

Submission Limit: Participants are only eligible to submit one application for the Selfie with a Senior Award. Applications submitted on previous years to the Selfie with a Senior Award will not be accepted. Participants can enter both the Selfie with a Senior Award and the Portrait of a Senior Territorian Art Award.

Copyright, reproduction and permissions: The participant warrants that the application (photograph and statement) does not infringe any copyright, moral rights, intellectual property rights or other rights of any third party.

The participant remains the copyright owner of the photograph and statement, and will be acknowledged as the owner at all times.

The photograph may be documented by inclusion in the Portrait of a Senior Territorian Art Award catalogue for archival and educational purposes.

By entering, the participant grants Tactile Arts and the Northern Territory Government a non-exclusive, non-commercial, perpetual, licence to freely use, reproduce, publish and communicate the selected photograph and statement for publicity, promotional and educational purposes, associated with the Award in print and digital media.

The winning photograph and statement may be reproduced to promote future Selfie with a Senior and Portrait of a Senior Territorian Art Awards.

The applicant grants Tactile Arts, COTA NT and the Northern Territory Government permission to provide the media with photos and information about the photograph, statement and applicant for the purpose of promoting or reporting on the exhibition or award recipients.

Privacy Policy: Tactile Arts is committed to ensuring the safety and security of personal data. Tactile Arts will only ask for data that is required to fulfil the application process.
